

## Knowle DGE Year 6 SATs Report 2017-18

Pupils working at the level of the tests for English reading, English SPAG and Mathematics are entered to take them. From 2016, the KS2 national curriculum test outcomes will be reported using scaled scores and not levels. A scaled score of 100 represents the 'expected standard'. Seven Year 6 pupils took SATs in June 2018. Three pupils working beneath the expected standard were dis-applied.

Reading scaled scores ranged from 81-93. The average scaled reading score was 86.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar scaled scores ranged from 81-93. The average scaled spelling, punctuation and grammar score was 88.7

Mathematics scaled scores ranged from 81 to 92. The average scaled mathematics score was 86.8

Although pupils did not meet expected standard over the course of Year 6, pupil progress was positive. In Reading 89% of pupils made expected or better than expected progress, 89% of pupils made expected or better than expected progress in writing and 78% of pupils made expected or better than expected progress in speaking and listening. In Number 89% of pupils made expected or better than expected progress. 100% of pupils made expected or better than expected progress in the other strands of mathematics.
