Our reading is really improving as we are reading every day at school! We also encourage reading at home.

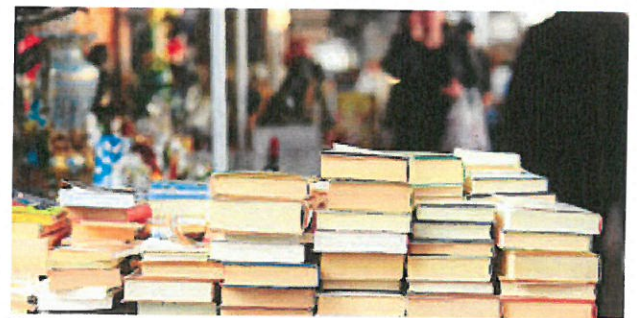
We have home-school diaries and we often send important letters home inside them. Please check them daily. We also like to write about all the fun things we do at school!
